IMS Policy Statement**

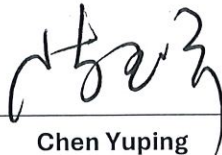

- Integrate risk and opportunity management into strategic planning, operational decision-making, change management and continual improvement.
- Maintain effective internal and external communication and ensure documented information is appropriately controlled, maintained, protected and available where required.
- Identify, investigate and learn from incidents, nonconformities, emergencies and disruptions, and implement effective corrective and preventive actions where applicable.
- Conduct planned audits, inspections, evaluations and management reviews to assess the continuing suitability, adequacy and effectiveness of the IMS.
- Promote a culture of quality, environmental responsibility, safety, security, continuity and resilience throughout CSP Abu Dhabi-CFS and with relevant contractors, suppliers and business partners.
- Continually improving the suitability, adequacy, effectiveness and resilience of the IMS, taking account of performance results, changing risks, lessons learned, stakeholder expectations and changes in the internal and external context.
